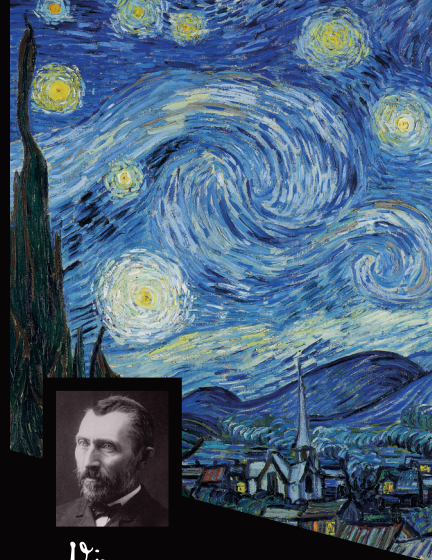
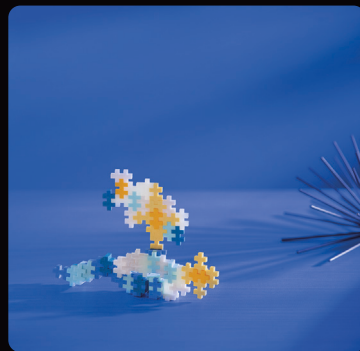

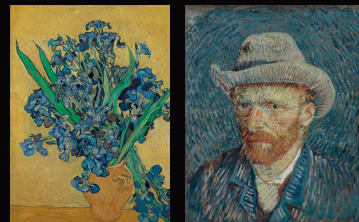

How does Vincent van Gogh's *The Starry Night* inspire you?

Vincent van Gogh's *The Starry Night*, painted in 1889 during his stay at the Saint-Rémy-de-Provence asylum, remains an enduring masterpiece reflecting his deep connection with nature and inner world. Despite a brief and initially unsuccessful career, Van Gogh's work now holds immense cultural value.

The painting portrays a dynamic night sky filled with swirling stars and a bright crescent moon above a peaceful village. In contrast, the lower portion features a dark, flame-like cypress, bridging the earthly and celestial realms. A simple village with softly lit windows and a prominent church



steeple rests below. Though inspired by the view from his asylum window, *The Starry Night* was largely a product of Van Gogh's memory, imagination, and emotional state. He was captivated by the night sky and sought to capture the "inner radiance" of the stars.

Van Gogh's distinctive style is evident through bold, textured brushstrokes (impasto), vibrant colors, and a sense of movement. The painting's emotional intensity reflects his personal struggles. Initially overlooked, *The Starry Night* has become an iconic symbol of Van Gogh's artistic brilliance and his remarkable ability to express the beauty and enigma of the natural world.
